Description: This seminar will examine the advancement of radiant heat and sound control for today's construction, and how it

effects the tile and stone industry. Tile and stone have excellent heat conduction qualities, but not as exceptional for sound abatement. Combining the two can be confusing, and if not properly addressed. could cause failure in the tile or stone floor. However, with proper details and specifications, the combination of in floor heat and sound

control could offer a long term, maintenance free flooring assembly that adds great value to a project.

Learning

Objectives: 1. Recognize two types of sound control ratings, Sound Transmission Class (STC) and Impact Insulation Class (IIC).

2. Distinguish between and IIC rating and a delta IIC contribution.

3. Identify the components of a floor/ceiling assembly required for effective sound control.

4. List the characteristics of different sound control materials suitable for use underneath a tiled floor covering.

Approach: A PowerPoint presentation that features various photos of design and installation procedures will be used.

There will be a question and answer period at the end of the program; however, questions are encouraged

throughout as well.
